Chart 1: Comparative Achievement of ACT Year 9 Students, NAPLAN, 2015

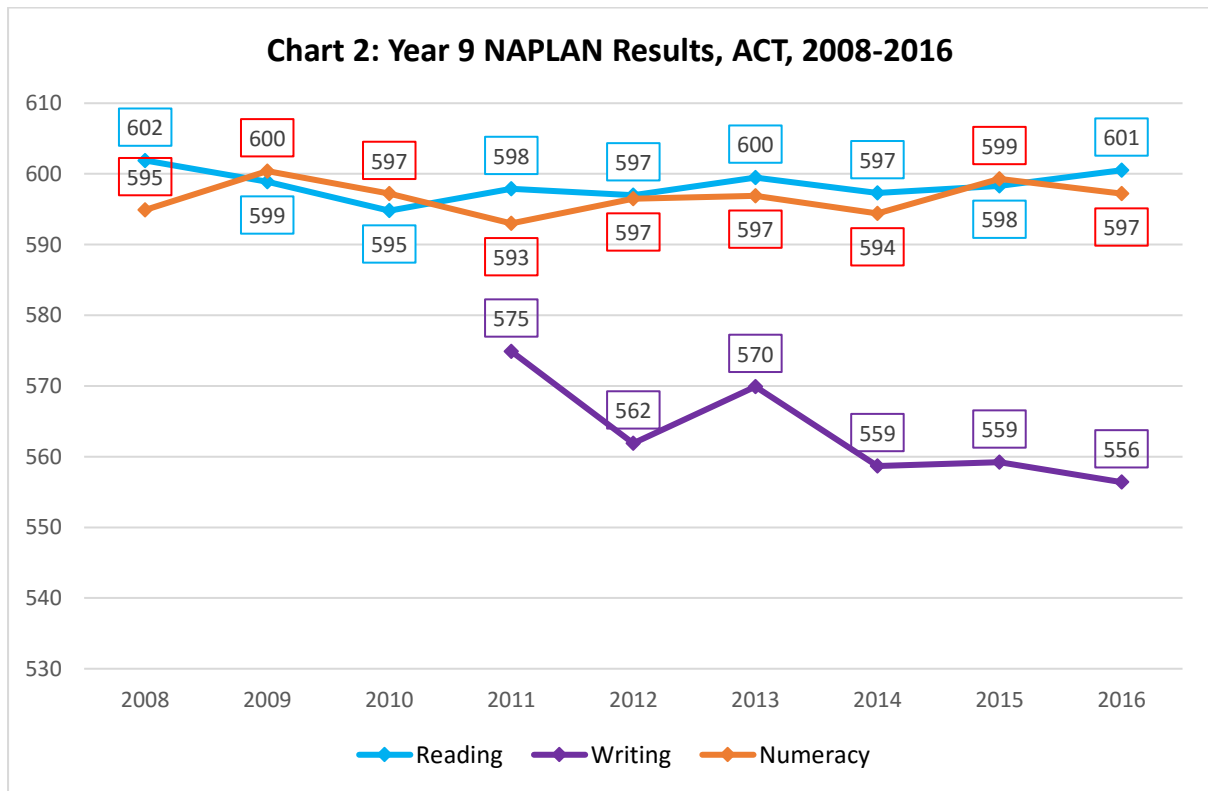

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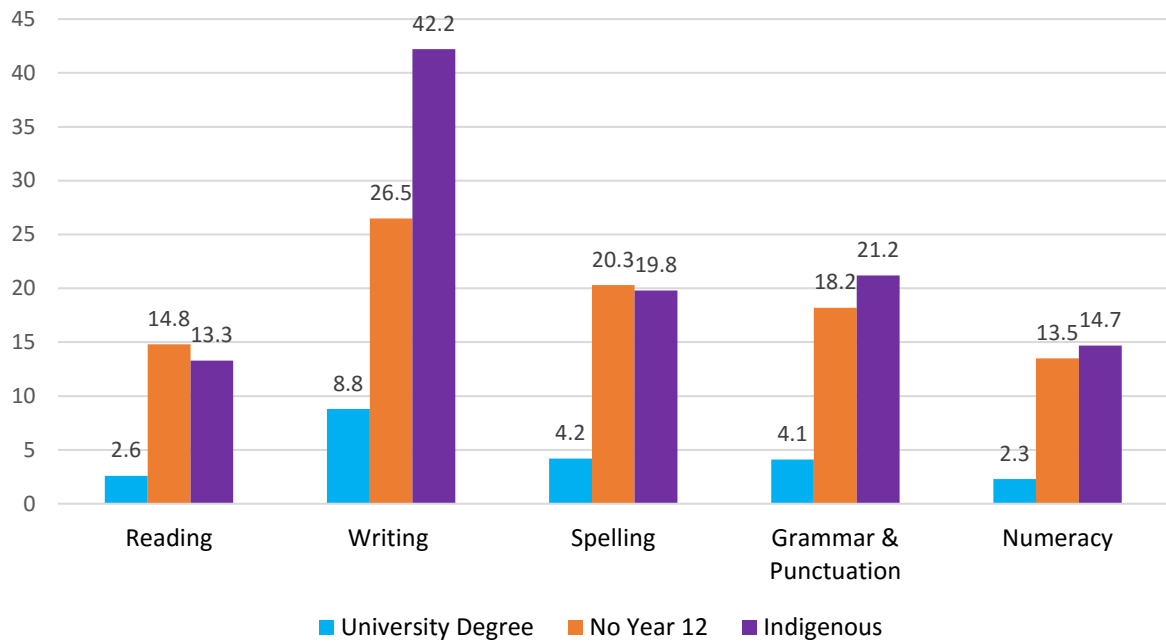

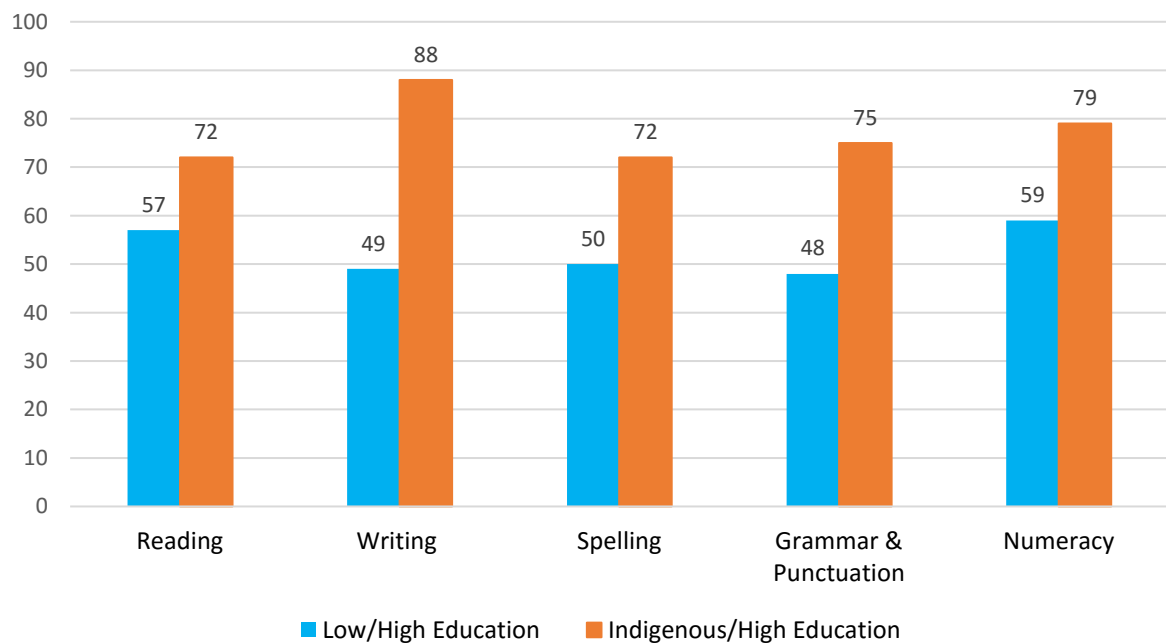

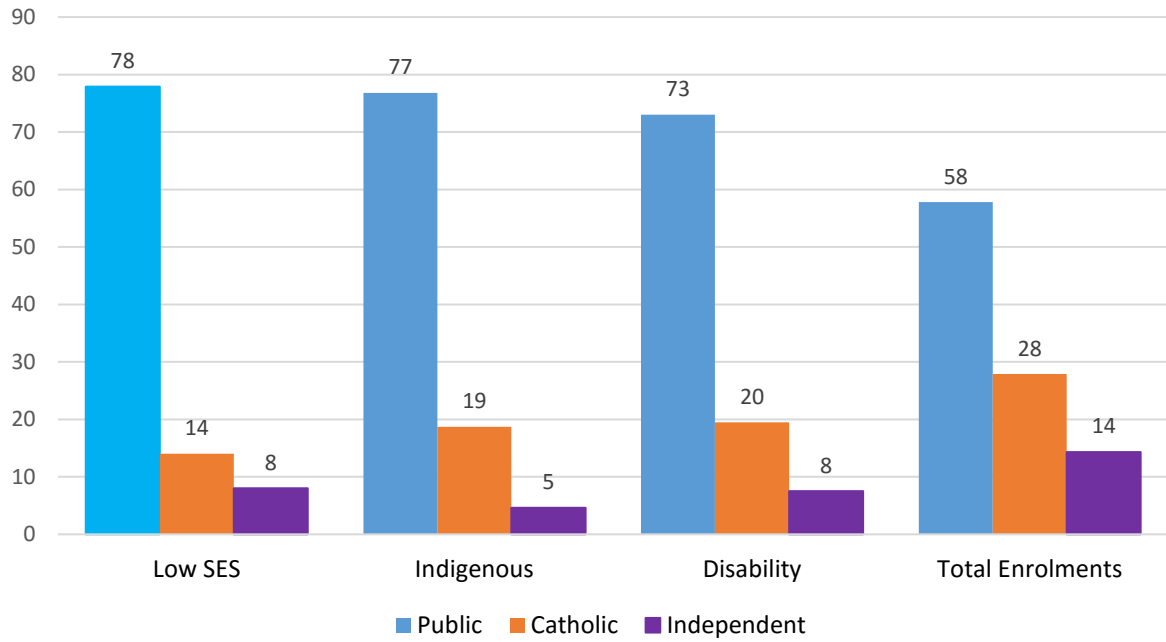
Chart 4: Achievement Gaps Between Year 9 Disadvantaged and Advantaged Students, ACT, 2015 (NAPLAN point scale)

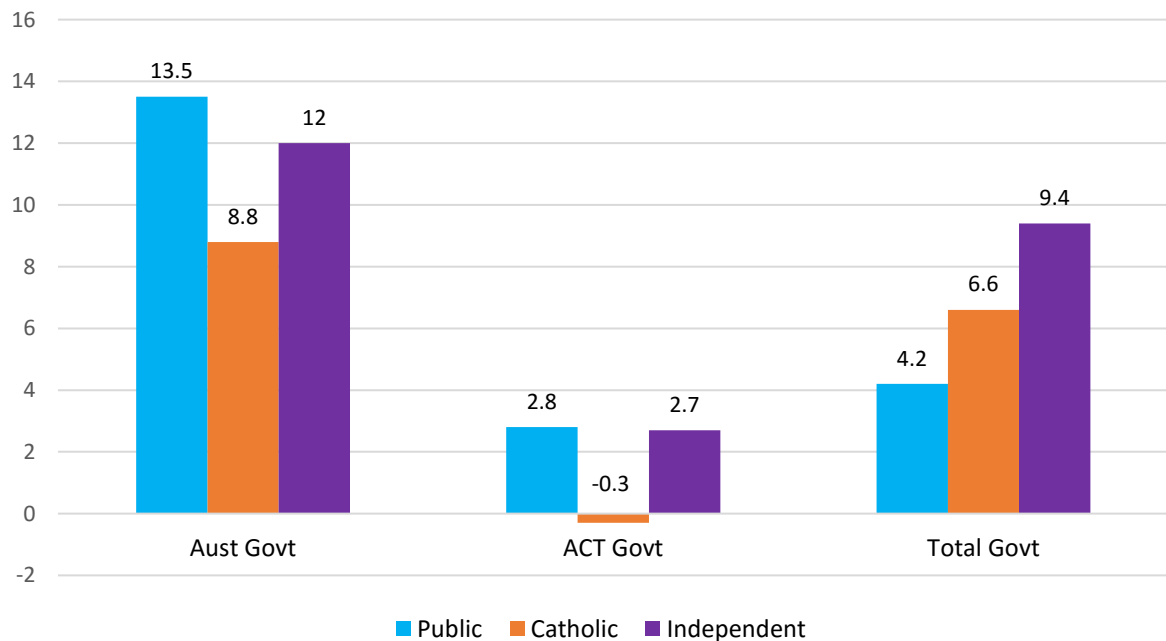
Note: One year of learning at Year 9 is equivalent to about 20 points on the NAPLAN scale.
