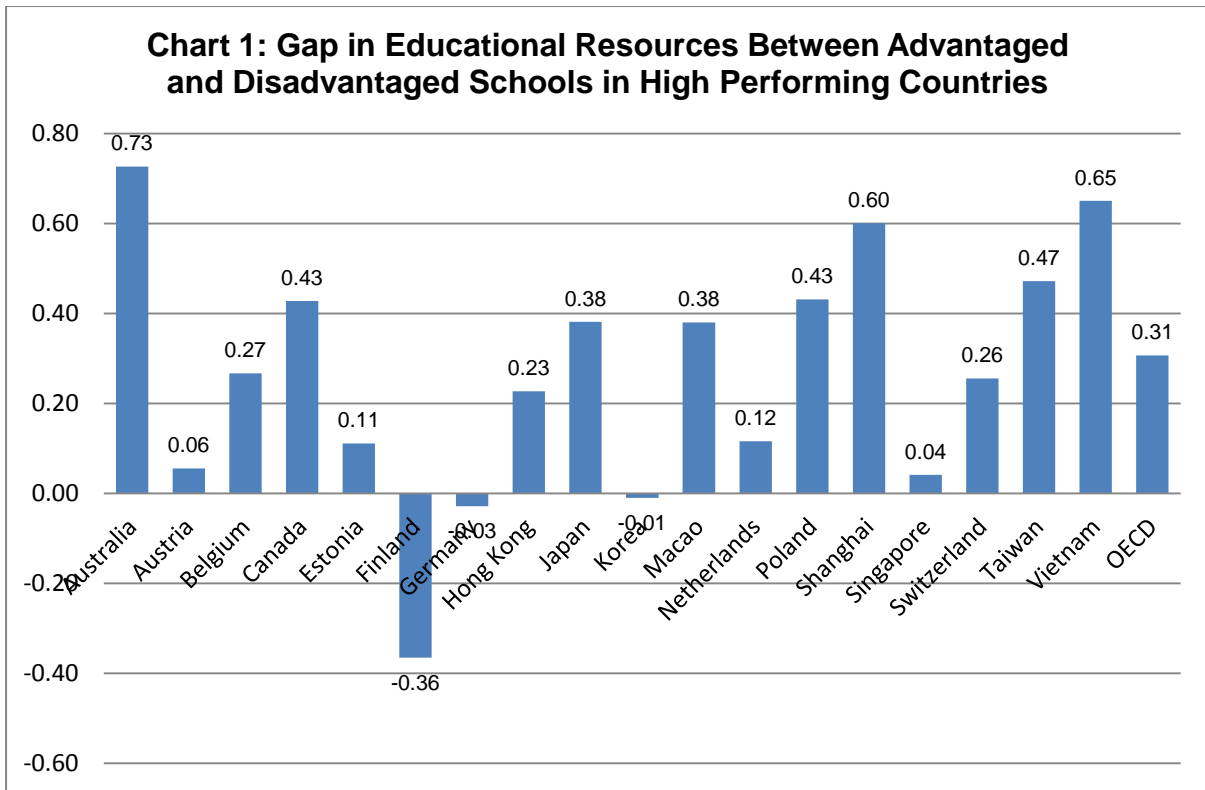


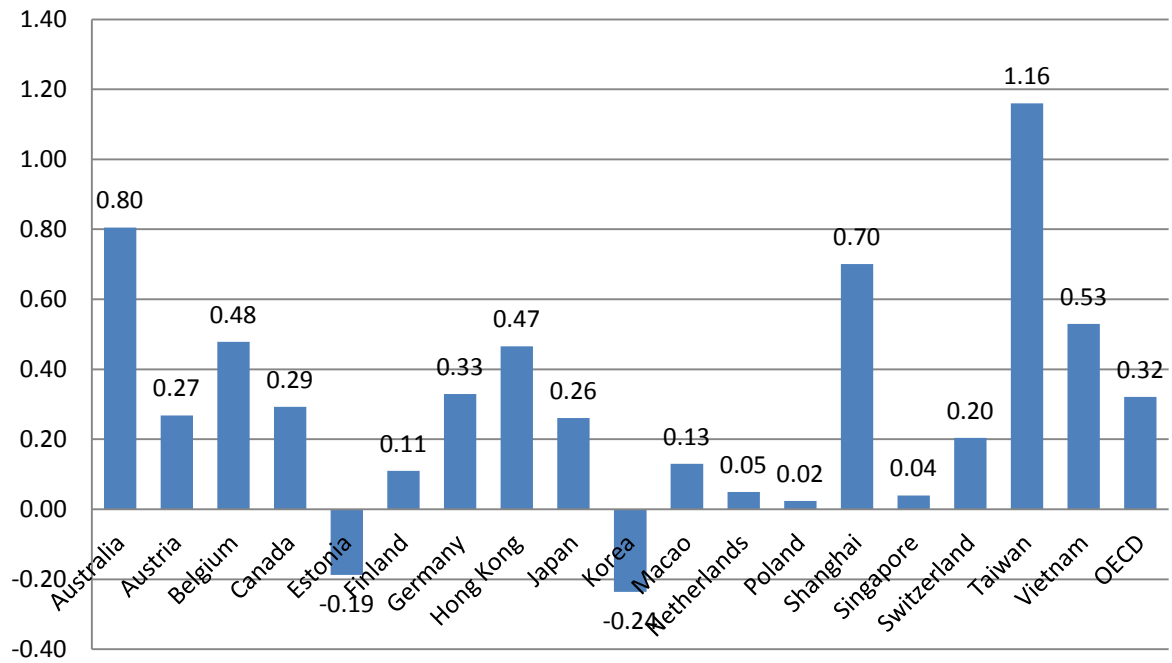
Charts on Educational Resources and Teacher Shortage Gaps
